Did you ever wonder how the Just Fore Kids Outing started? Or where in the World Mike White concocted the Heads or Tails Television giveaway or some of the other fun golf gimmicks he has presented over the years?

We interviewed the Founder and President of the Just Fore Kids Golf Outing, Mike White to answer these questions and a few more:

How (and when) did the Just Fore Kids Outing Start? JFK was a continuation of the White Open which started in 1989 with family and friends on a mission to raise money for kids. The early years primarily focused on adoption and foster care since Tami and I adopted our two daughters.

Besides yourself, what players have posted the most rounds in the Just Fore Kids/White Open? I believe the only person to make all 34 besides me is Jim White

What is the lowest winning score in Outing History? The lowest score ever is 17-under at Broadlands, the year before we moved the outing back to New Berlin Hills.

What is the history behind the Heads or Tails TV Giveaway? Heads and Tails I saw at a Childrens Hospital charity dinner so used that every year after--a great way to end the night where anyone can win.

What was the most liked gift in history (Sunglasses, booze, pullover, shirt, gift card, etc.)

Hard to pick best check in gift as everyone has their own taste but i usually get great feedback on all of them so far. Many times, I hear " best check in gift ever! " which is awesome.

What were the main/highlighted charities where the JFK Board donated to this year? Over 17 different recipients: I love the fact that we range from large size (Childrens Hospital, Big Brothers Big Sisters), medium size: Chosen, Lighthouse Youth Center, to individual families that need some extra help.

What is your favorite golf "gimmick" that you have presented? (Golf ball cannons, Whitey Logo Ball find, 180-person ball throw, etc.) I don't like gimmicks that affect the outcome like cannon or mulligans but love the fun ones that include everyone but I'm always trying to think of something new.
